HIGHWAYS

- Traffic calming letter already submitted to Highways at OCC. Decision not to approach OCC regarding reverting to 30mph as this is contrary to their policy and would not be supported by residents of houses along the route
- Discussion re damaged wall/railing along Silver Street. Barriers have been installed and OCC claim it will consider allocating resources and programming works. ACTION: Given the long delays so far, Chairman to write to Head of Service at Highways Sean Rooney, copied to Cllr Chris Brant at OCC.

KEEPING VILLAGERS BETTER INFORMED REGARDING PLANNING

- In view of all Parish Councils being subject to a government directive to change electronic
 communications to suffix .gov.uk by the end of the current FY, the Parish Council has been
 exploring suppliers and logistics. It was therefore agreed that this provided an opportunity
 for designing a specific Parish Council website, which could be accessed by all villagers and
 populated directly by the PC, with easy to access planning and other relevant information.
- Cllr Robarts & the Clerk are in discussion with suppliers and will communicate results as appropriate.
- In order to facilitate this during this FY, an allocation of £2000 was agreed. ACTION Clerk to
 ensure a motion for ratification of the allocation is included on the agenda at the next
 meeting.

c) Clerk update:

- New website/email research undertaken already discussed above.
- DEFIB at Wroxton school update: there is a defib on the school site Clerk to explore out of school hours access including the PC offering to meet the cost of a possible relocation of the device to an external position.
- Clerk accepted on the Liaison group for Alkerton Quarry.
